

Colorado's K-12 TEST TO STAY

Instructions for Exposed Students and Staff

For asymptomatic (without symptoms) Close Contacts* of an individual with COVID-19 infection**

This tool is not for individuals who have tested positive or have symptoms of COVID -19.

**Close Contacts are determined by school health personnel or public health professionals.*

***Anyone with suspect, probable, or confirmed COVID-19.*

YOU ARE EXEMPT FROM QUARANTINE, IF YOU ARE:

- Up to date with recommended COVID-19 vaccinations, bit.ly/cdcuptodate, or
- Viral test-confirmed infection in past 90 days, or
- Protected because you and the case were wearing a well-fitted mask during the exposure, or
- Participating in weekly screening testing and will continue to participate for at least two additional weeks.

Monitor for symptoms, and wear a well-fitting mask consistently and correctly around others for a full 10 days following your last exposure.

ARE YOU EXEMPT FROM QUARANTINE?

Wear a well-fitting mask around others for 10 full days.

HAVE YOU OPTED INTO THE TEST TO STAY?

Wear a well-fitting mask around others for 10 full days.

STAY HOME

and complete quarantine.

INSTRUCTIONS

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COMPLETE QUARANTINE AS INSTRUCTED BY SCHOOL HEALTH OR PUBLIC HEALTH:

Return to school after completing at least 5 full days of quarantine as instructed as long as you:

- Remain asymptomatic, **and**
- Wear a well-fitting mask consistently and correctly while around others for 10 full days since your last exposure, **and**
- Get tested on day 5 after your exposure, even if you do not have symptoms, **and**
- If symptoms develop or you test positive, stay home and following instructions for isolation.

REMAIN IN SCHOOL IF YOU:

Opted in to Test to Stay and agree to the requirements, including:

- Monitor for symptoms daily for a full 10 days from last exposure, **and**
- Test at least twice using the Abbott BinaxNOW test kit provided by the school, once upon notification of their close contact and again 5-7 days after their last close contact with a person with COVID-19, **and**
- Continue to remain asymptomatic and test negative, **and**
- Report testing results as instructed, using the Abbott Navica app tinyurl.com/25f93nrv, **and**
- Wear a well-fitting mask consistently and correctly around others except when eating or drinking for a full 10 days from the last day of exposure, **and**
- If symptoms develop or you test positive, stay home and follow instructions for isolation.
